AARP TAX RETURN ASSISTANCE

New Providence area residents can obtain FREE AARP Foundation Tax-Aide assistance in preparing and filing their 2024 tax returns. AARP Foundation Tax Aide counselors will be available at the DeCorso Center for appointments on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from February through mid-April.

Trained AARP Foundation Tax-Aide volunteers will provide in-person tax assistance free of charge, with a focus on taxpayers who are over 50 and have low to moderate income. Taxpayers with complex returns may be advised to seek paid assistance. Beginning Tuesday, January 21, taxpayers may call the DeCorso Center at (908) 665-0046 between 10:00am and 2:00pm Mondays through Fridays to schedule an appointment, or they may sign up in person at the Center.
