As web use among senior citizens increases, so do their chances to fall victim to internet fraud. Internet Fraud includes internet auction fraud, non-delivery of merchandise, and credit and debit card scams. This month, we will explore how to avoid the Nigerian Letter or "419" fraud.

Tips for Avoiding the Nigerian Letter or "419" Fraud:

- Be skeptical of individuals representing themselves as Nigerian or foreign government officials asking for your help in placing large sums of money in overseas bank accounts.
- Do not believe the promise of large sums of money for your cooperation.
- Guard your account information carefully.
