On January 21, 2025 at approximately 8:54 am, a resident of Verona Road reported receiving an email regarding a new credit card that was opened in their name. The fraud is currently under investigation by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

On January 21, 2025 at approximately 1:20 pm, a resident of Holmes Oval reported a fraudulent withdrawal from their electronic bank account and attempts to transfer money to an unknown suspect's account. The fraud is currently under investigation by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

On January 23, 2025 at approximately 3:13 pm, patrols responded to a report of a juvenile attempting to cause damage to a structure at Oakwood Park. The juvenile was located and their parent was contacted to advise them of the damage. The case was forwarded to the Juvenile Detective.
