New Providence Police Department Press Release

April 17, 2025

On April 1, 2025 at approximately 7:32 pm, a resident of Pittsford Way reported their new credit card was stolen from the mail and used at the Short Hills Mall. The theft and fraud is currently under investigation by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

On April 2, 2025 at approximately 11:58 am, Justin Yungamuzha, age 19, of Plainfield was arrested for possession of false government documents and displaying a false insurance card after his vehicle was stopped for motor vehicle violations. Mr. Yungamuzha was charged and released pending a Union County Superior Court date.

On April 7, 2025 at approximately 4:34 pm, Yerikson Mercedes-Fabian, age 35, of Jersey City was arrested for theft after an investigation was conducted into the theft of a package from a Central Avenue residence that occurred on December 18, 2024. The victim reported a package containing an iPhone was stolen from their front porch moments after being placed there by the delivery driver.
