New Providence Police Department Press Release

On May 17, 2025 at approximately 9:32 pm, officers responded to a restaurant on Springfield Avenue on a report of a customer screaming and cursing at employees. The customer reportedly began throwing food and appliances before leaving. The criminal mischief is currently under investigation by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

On May 18, 2025 at approximately 11:55 am, Byron Viveros-Banguero, age 30, of North Bergen was arrested on an outstanding traffic warrant after his vehicle was stopped on Southgate Road for having a suspended registration. Mr. Viveros-Banguero was issued numerous traffic summons and released pending a Palisades Interstate Park court date.

On May 24, 2025 at approximately 4:13 pm, Jhoan Huertas Carabali, age 21, of Elizabeth was arrested for DWI after his vehicle was stopped for motor vehicle violations on South Street. After an investigation was conducted, it was determined that he was under the influence of an intoxicating substance. Mr. Huertas Carabali was charged with DWI along with several other motor vehicle violations and was released to a sober party pending a New Providence Municipal Court date.

On May 29, 2025 at approximately 3:34 pm, patrol officers responded to a restaurant on South Street on a report of an intoxicated male harassing other patrons. Officers located the male and conducted an investigation, ultimately arresting Michael Lizardi, age 49, of New Providence for Disorderly Conduct, Resisting Arrest, and Criminal Mischief. He was issued a mandatory New Providence Municipal Court date.
