### New Providence Police Department Press Release

June 16, 2025

On June 1, 2025 at approximately 12:25 am, Oscar Morocho Morocho, age 41, of Springfield was arrested for DWI after his vehicle was stopped for motor vehicle violations on Mountain Avenue. After an investigation was conducted, it was determined that he was under the influence of an intoxicating substance. Mr. Morocho Morocho was charged with DWI along with several motor vehicle violations. He was released to a sober party pending a New Providence Municipal Court date.

On June 6, 2025 at approximately 1:57 pm, Marco Cuautleazcatl, age 29, of Passaic was arrested for DWI after his vehicle was found to be parked illegally on South Street. After an investigation was conducted, it was determined that he was under the influence of an intoxicating substance. Mr. Cuautleazcatl was charged with DWI along with motor vehicle violations for consumption of alcohol in a motor vehicle and having an open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle. He was released to a sober party pending a New Providence Municipal Court date.

On June 9, 2025 at approximately 10:50 am, officers responded to a residence on Possum Way on a report of a suspicious incident. The resident reported that a delivery service rang their doorbell to advise that the delivery of two laptops was made. As the resident went to retrieve the delivery from their front porch, another male wearing an Amazon shirt was walking towards the porch and placed another box down. The resident indicated that he later found that this package was empty. It is believed that the package was a decoy to make it look like the unknown male was making a delivery when he was really there to steal the first delivery. The attempted theft is currently under investigation by the New Providence Detective Bureau.

On June 11, 2025 at approximately 12:42 am, Edwin Nettles, age 25, of Irvington was arrested for DWI after his vehicle was stopped for motor vehicle violations on South Street. After an investigation was conducted, it was determined that he was under the influence of an intoxicating substance. Mr. Nettles was charged with DWI along with several motor vehicle violations. He was released to a sober party pending a court date.

On June 12, 2025 at approximately 10:01 pm, officers responded to a restaurant off of Springfield Avenue on a report of a stolen bicycle. It was reported that an employee's bicycle was stolen between 5:00 and 9:00 pm after being left unlocked outside of the restaurant. The theft is currently under investigation by the New Providence Detective Bureau.
