### **Press Release Pedestrian Involved Crash**

**June 24, 2025**

On June 24, 2025 at approximately 12:27 PM, officers responded to the intersection of Springfield Avenue and Central Avenue on a report of a pedestrian being struck by a motor vehicle. At the time of the incident, the pedestrian was holding a baby. Initial 9-1-1 reports from witnesses indicated that there were injuries sustained by the pedestrian. Upon arrival, officers and EMS evaluated the pedestrian and baby. Minor injuries were reported by the adult pedestrian who was transported by EMS to the hospital. No injuries were reported to the baby. The baby was taken to the pediatrician by a parent as a precaution. The initial investigation revealed that the pedestrian was on Springfield Avenue crossing Central Avenue and was struck by the vehicle as it made a left turn. The driver of the vehicle that struck the pedestrian was issued a summons.
