



Trading Card Program Guidelines

For a safe and fun experience



Only approach an officer when they are NOT assisting others, providing first aid, conducting a traffic stop, directing traffic or helping students to cross the street.



Do not approach a police vehicle with its emergency lights flashing even if it is stopped.



When you approach an officer introduce yourself, share your age, where you go to school and anything else you would like to mention.



If an officer receives a call, they may need to leave abruptly.



If requested, officers will sign trading cards.

Parents should NOT collect cards for children. The idea is to promote positive interactions with young residents and New Providence Police Officers.

Only collect one card for each New Providence Police Officer, Detective, Administrator and the Mayor.

Participating businesses will also feature officers cards for collection.

Collect all 30 trading cards to be entered into the prize lottery.

Bring children to Police Headquarters to have your card collection verified and to provide contact information for parent or guardian.

Prize Lottery Details

- If children, collect 30 out of 30 cards, they will be entered into the lottery.
- Children who collect all 30 cards will also receive a Department Goodie Bag or gift card from one of participating local businesses.
