Alzheimer's & Brain Awareness Month

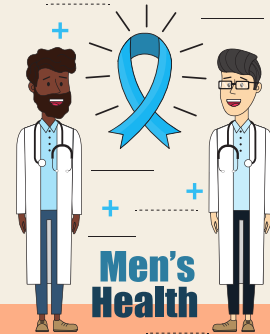
